TORWOOD STREET SITE GETS GREEN LIGHT



The £26m Torwood Street Development is set to revitalise a derelict site at the heart of Torquay's Harbourside after Conservatives on Torbay Council promoted a deal to get work underway.

After much anticipation a part of Torquay Town Centre which has been blighted by derelict shops and scruffy hoardings for years will soon have a bright new look.

The area near Torquay's Harbourside will be transformed with the construction of a 113 bed Hotel, 3 new Restaurants, 3 offices and a Gym.

The development will see hundreds of new jobs created and deliver the type of modern facilities workers, residents and tourists want to see in our bay. Construction workers are expected to be on site this summer and for the work to take 2 years to complete.

The decision to get the development underway followed a loan package being offered by Torbay Council as part of its Investment Strategy.

Conservative Group Leader, Cllr David Thomas, said: "The clear message residents have been giving is they want to see action to regenerate our Town Centres. I met with the developer in London earlier this year for talks to get this long-awaited scheme underway, I am therefore delighted this scheme it is now set to start and will make a real difference."
